Race 2 Inquiry. Reviewed possible break in stride by # 1 Century Jamila (A. Sorrie) at the top of the stretch. # 1 gets rough-gaited and does not make a break. Finished 2<sup>nd</sup>. No violation.

Race 3 Clear

Race 4 # 5 Mass Market (J. MacDonald) finished 7<sup>th</sup> and was placed 8<sup>th</sup> for an extended break in the stretch. # 5 was examined post-race by the Commission Vet and placed on the Vets list short-term lame.

Race 5 Clear

Race 6 Spoke to Sylvain Filion, the driver of race favourite # 8 Nimah Franco N. Mr. Filion stated that when he was sitting 3<sup>rd</sup> going to ¾'s he attempted to pull, but the horse on front came to a walk and he didn't have sufficient room to get out when the outside horses advanced quickly.

Race 7 Inquiry. # 3 Incredible MVP (Jean Bernard Renaud) finished 4<sup>th</sup> and was placed 8<sup>th</sup> for going inside 4 consecutive pylons going to ¾'s. No penalty to Mr. Renaud as the horse was having steering issues.

Race 8 # 8 Century Jaguar was a late Vet scratch lame by the Commission Vet. Horse goes on the Vets list short-term.

Inquiry. # 5 All Star Yankee (J. Drury) made a break before the start and was refunded. Total refund on the race was \$28,085. No video needed.

Race 9 Inquiry. Reviewed possible pylon violation by # 4 HP Extra Ice (J. MacDonald) going to the ½. After reviewing the video and speaking to Mr. MacDonald, # 4 did go inside 2 pylons but was forced in for safety reasons due to the race jamming up in front.
