Review of yesterdays ninth race with riders Sahin Civaci, Leo Salles and JBAC representative, Justin Stein. Apprentice Sophia Vives was also present. Leo said he was inside Sahin around the five and a half when he came over on me until he pushed me into the fence, I was yelling but he continued in on me. Sahin said pace was slow and tried to get back off the horse in front, was in front of Leo the whole time and it was he who ran into the situation, shouldn't have run up in there, bad spot. After review, it was decided Sahin is to be levied a three day suspension for the interference, days to be determined.

Review of yesterdays second race with Eswan Flores for raising his hand above her head and excessive use of the crop through the stretch. Eswan said he is trying to do his best for his owner, trainer and the public. It is hard to change but understands his obligations. This is a third offence within a year and therefore, Mr. Flores was levied a \$500 monetary penalty and a three day suspension, day to be determined.

Race 4 – Stewards reviewed the run away from the gate regarding #5 "Commander Tom" with Leo Salles, #6 "Tall Water" with Steve Jadoo and #8 "One Punch Charlie" ridden by Jodeien Anderson. Steve said he was in a bad spot, #8 with Jodeien came over on me very quickly, pushed me into the #5, I was on heels, surprised I didn't go down. Leo said he didn't understand why the #6 came into me from the outside, his horses head was in my lap, think he was in trouble from the horse to his outside. Jodeien said he stayed straight, looked twice to my inside before I went over, didn't bother anyone. After review, #8 was disqualified from fifth position and placed last behind #5 for interference.
